He named it Full Circle as he had gone full circle, ending up as he began, as a florist in Hubbard! He moved the store to its current location at 808 Elm Street in 2005. There, patrons can find floral arrangements and gifts for weddings, holidays, and special occasions created by Rodd or by co-owner Jack Peterson.
